

In what has become an annual tradition, Wendy Woo and her band are returning to Mary's Lake Lodge for New Year's Eve.

One of Colorado's most popular performers, with a string of "Best of" awards from a variety of sources (including so many from Westword that they put her in their Hall of Fame), Woo has earned these recognitions both as a songwriter and as a musician.

Seven albums into her career, she is still creating audience-pleasing music that has spanned a variety of genres including folk, jazz, blues, funk, rock, and pop. This depth of material has allowed Woo the versatility to play some of the country's most popular venues, including the Hotel Cafe in LA; the Bitter End and the Living Room in New York City; the Lizard Lounge in the Boston area; the Bluebird Cafe in Nashville; Jammin' Java in the DC area; Eddie's Attic in the Atlanta area; and Red Rocks, the Fillmore, and the Fox in Colorado.

Ever-evolving, Woo recently added a fifth band member, Robin Hoch (from The Lovely and Talented) on viola and vocals. So if you haven't been to a show lately, come check out the new sound, party, and dance. And of course, you will hear many old favorites as well.
